

Espace de l'Art Concret - MOUANS-SARTOUX

Founded in 1990, the Espace de l'Art Concret is a contemporary art centre of national interest with a collection of abstract art unique in France, the Donation Albers-Honegger.

This collection, included in the inventory of the Centre National des Arts Plastiques since 2000, today features almost 700 works of art from the top names in concrete art, as well as the most important players in minimalism, conceptual art, the supports/surfaces movement and the New Realists, testifying to the visionary spirit of the two Swiss collectors Sybil Albers and Gottfried Honegger, who made the donation to the State, and founded the art centre.

From the time of its creation, the eac. has made art the focal point of life. Its artistic, cultural and educational initiatives revolve around three complementary missions: conservation and promotion of the Albers-Honegger collection - research linked to temporary exhibitions and artists in residence - educating and raising public awareness about art today through mediations in exhibitions and artistic practice workshops.

International Perfume Museum - GRASSE

The International Perfume Museum, located in the birthplace of perfume making, retraces the world history of perfumes and showcases the know-how and ingenuity of Grasse-based industries. It is also a unique place, offering a multi-sensory approach to understanding the manufacture of perfumes and aromas, but also the use of fragrance for cultural, medicinal and seductive purposes.

The museum takes an anthropological approach to the history of fragrances in all its aspects - raw materials, manufacturing, industry, innovation and design through a wide variety of forms, including decorative arts, industrial heritage and ethnography.

In addition to the main part of the museum, visitors are offered further materials that open a discourse on an artistic vision of the world of fragrances. It has given free rein to several internationally-renowned contemporary artists to fit out some of the museum's indoor and outdoor spaces. The works of art created by Berdaguer & Péjus, Gérard Collin-Thiébaut, Peter Downsbrough, Brigitte Nahon, Jean-Michel Othoniel and Dominique Thévenin are inspired by the world of fragrance: scents and the awakening of the senses, luxury and design, glassworks and interplay of transparencies, industry and materials.
